THE COURSE

Award in Education and Training Level 3 (PTLLS) is designed to give people the knowledge and confidence to teach in the post 16 education sector.

The course is made up of three core units. Unit A looks at the role and responsibilities of a trainer/teacher and investigates the skills required to create an effective learning environment.

Unit B is largely practical and each learner is required to plan, deliver and evaluate their own 15 minute micro-teach on a subject of their choice.

Unit C investigates the different types of assessment within teaching and how assessment is a pivotal element of successful teaching.

GOOD TO KNOW

The course is delivered over 4 days and is accredited by Open College Network West Midlands, a final portfolio of evidence comprising of 3 assignments & microteach will be assessed.
